Steve Dockrill is a Senior Lecturer in Archaeology. His research has focused on the archaeology of North Atlantic Britain where he has directed a number of projects including Tofts Ness, Orkney and South Nesting. Since 1995 Dockrill has directed excavations at Old Scatness (an Iron Age to Norse village) in collaboration with Shetland Amenity Trust and has also worked with Bond on Neolithic to Norse levels at Jarlshof. With other NABO colleagues, he co-directs the Heart of the Atlantic project in the Faroes & has initiated the new Orkney 'Gateway to the Atlantic' project.
