Cory Look is a PhD student studying the archaeology of climate change in the Caribbean. He is interested in how we can look to the past in order to better mitigate the challenging effects of environmental change as it relates to climate. This includes the modeling of vulnerability and risk, particularly changing sea levels, hurricane activity, storminess, and storm surge. He has been applying this research in Antigua and Barbuda by utilizing non-destructive remote sensing as it is applied to landscape archaeology and integrating spatial data collected for both seascape and landscape features. This research materializes out of collaboration with the Barbuda Council and the Barbuda National Heritage Committee. Cory has also been working in Israel modeling Late Bronze Age destruction at Tel Beit Shemesh. He has served as a Chancellor Teaching Fellow with the Department of Anthropology and Archaeology at Brooklyn College since 2007.
