John Steinberg is a survey archaeologist with fieldwork experience in Eastern North America, Northern Europe, Mesoamerica, and Southern Africa. His major focus is on the European expansion during the Viking Age (c 800-1300 AD) and the resulting settlement patterns found in Northern Iceland. Since 2000 he has helped direct the Skagafjörður Archaeological Settlement Survey (SASS). SASS is a NSF funded project that seeks to chronicle 12 farms of varying social and economic status, in a small part of Skagafjörður, over the first 500 years of Icelandic Settlement. Since 2005 he has been a Research Scientist at the Fiske Center for Archaeological Research at UMass Boston.
