## **Biography**

I graduated from the University of Rouen, France and the University of Iceland in 2009 with a BA in History and Archaeology. After returning in France I completed my MA in Medieval Archaeology with a thesis on population and housing in Iceland in the days of the landnám oriented on foundation deposit rituals at the University of Nanterre-Ouest Paris X, supervised by Dr Brigitte Boissavit-Camus, Dr Jean-Pierre Caillet and the expertise of Dr Karen Milek.
